

DULUTH POLICE DEPARTMENT STUDENT INTERN PROGRAM

The Duluth Police Department administers a student intern program designed to provide first-hand observation of the law enforcement role in the community. The student intern program is open to law enforcement and criminal justice students to augment their education and provide an inside perspective of the demands of a policing career.

The Department can accommodate up to three interns per semester and will accept only those students who are recommended by the Program Coordinator of the participating school. The length of the program is based on the school's credit/hour requirements.

Interns are accepted in the following priority:

1. UMD and UWS Criminology Students
2. Local residents attending college (in related field of study) outside Duluth
3. Students from other law enforcement programs.

Recommendations for internships must originate from the Program Coordinator of the participating school. Recommendations should be sent to the Intern Coordinator, Duluth Police Department, 2030 North Arlington Ave., Duluth, Minnesota 55811, at least 30 days prior to the beginning of the semester the internship is desired.

Once a student receives preliminary approval from the Program Coordinator, the student completes an application/background. Students will participate in a formal interview process. If accepted, the student must submit to a background check. In addition, students must sign a contract, code of conduct agreement, and waiver of liability.
