IT IS RESOLVED by the Duluth Parking Commission to convert the time limit for on-street parking meters on the 400 block of West First Street to two hours.



IT IS RESOLVED by the Duluth Parking Commission to convert a city vehicle parking zone at 411 West First Street to two single-space meters.



- 3 North Fourth Avenue West – 1 meter


STATEMENT OF PURPOSE:


To reconfigure a loading zone on East Superior Street.


STATEMENT OF PURPOSE:

5 – 6 Hours = \$7.00
6 – 7 Hours = \$8.00
7 – 8 Hours = \$9.00
8 – 12 Hours = \$10.00


STATEMENT OF PURPOSE:


STATEMENT OF PURPOSE:


