RESOLUTION 2017-25

September 1, 2017

To establish a first-hour-free rate structure at four municipal downtown parking ramps.


IT IS RESOLVED by the Duluth Parking Commission to establish the first-hour-free rate structure illustrated in Exhibit A at the four major downtown parking ramps. This rate structure would take effect on November 1, 2017. While the first hour would remain free for at least one year, the remainder of the rate structure would be subject to change during this time period.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE:


This action serves to provide an incentive and convenience to parkers visiting downtown Duluth, with the intent of encouraging off-street parking.

IT IS RESOLVED by the Duluth Parking Commission to establish a flat fee night rate of \$2.00 at Medical District Ramp.


STATEMENT OF PURPOSE:



IT IS RESOLVED by the Duluth Parking Commission to install on-street ADA parking signage to serve visitors to the business at 624 East 1st Street.



IT IS RESOLVED by the Duluth Parking Commission to install on-street ADA parking signage to serve the resident(s) at 422 Minneapolis Avenue.


