
To convert a no parking/bus drop-off zone on Pitt Street to a ten-minute drop-off zone.

IT IS RESOLVED by the Duluth Parking Commission to prohibit parking on the south side and eastern end of 31st Street South.


STATEMENT OF PURPOSE:
