The City of Duluth would like to inform residents of the Lincoln Park neighborhood, on Monday, November 19th, a Utility Operations crew will be repairing a fire hydrant in front of 1801 West Skyline Parkway (Enger Golf Course). As a result of this repair, the upper portion of the Lincoln Park neighborhood may experience a drop in water pressure while the work is going on.
