[Duluth, MN] - Duluth Mayor Emily Larson is continuing her commitment of outreach to Duluth residents through City Hall in the City Community Listening sessions that are held in neighborhoods across the city. Mayor Larson started these listening sessions in partnership with City Councilors to ensure residents have an opportunity to speak directly to their elected officials one-on-one. Several sessions remain for resident participation for the remainder of the year.

City staff are also in attendance and represent Public Works, Parks, Finance, Public Safety, Human Rights, and Imagine Duluth 2035. The previous sessions enabled residents to have individualize conversations with the Mayor, City Councilors or City staff about various issues or suggestions.

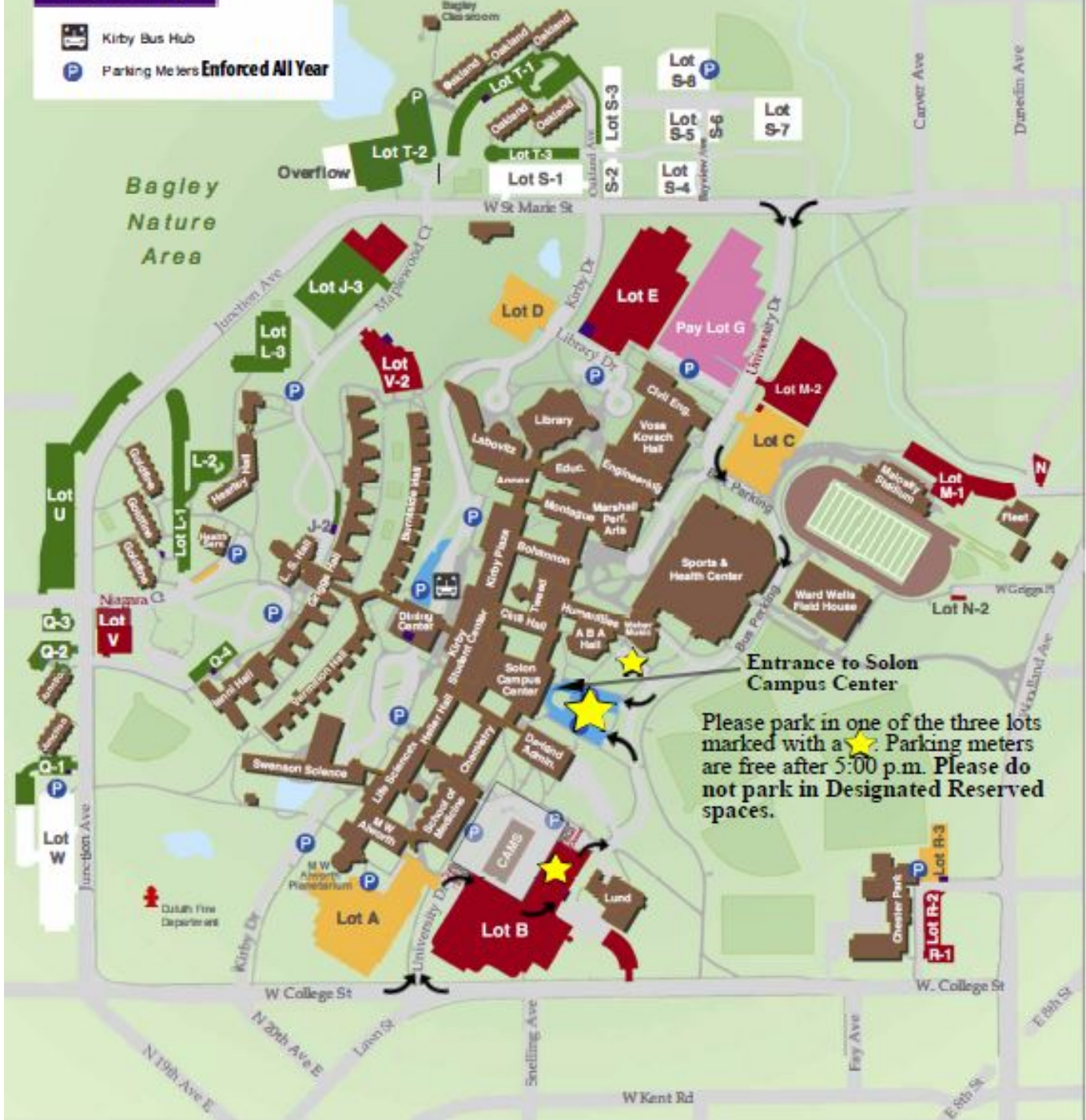
