Parking at meters is free after 5:00 p.m., and those who attend can also park in Lot E. A parking map is attached.

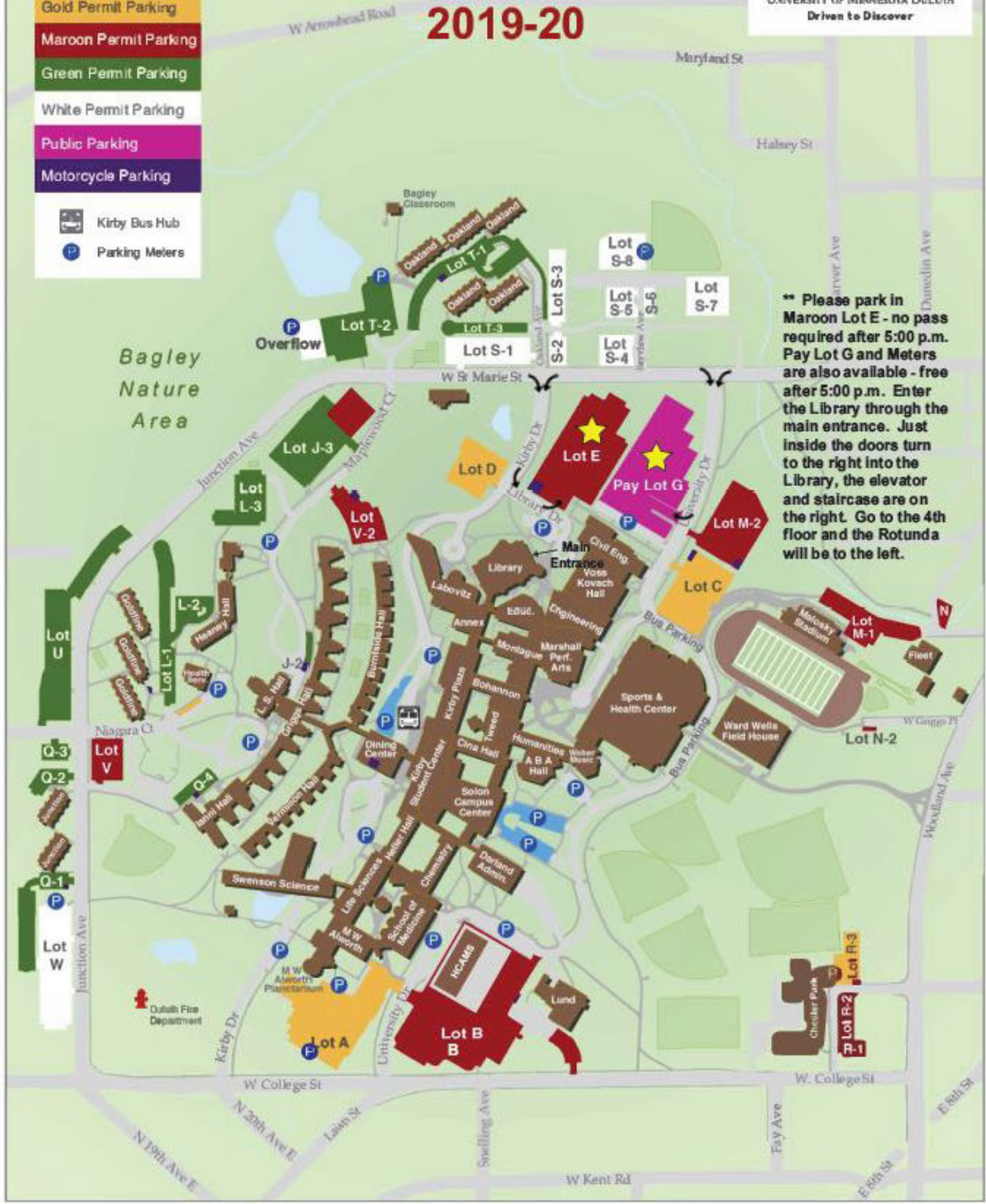
