STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution will authorize award of the Perimeter Road paving, Phase 2, in the amount of \$793,081.42 to Northland Constructors of Duluth, LLC. This project is a federal high priority project funded in part by the U.S. department of transportation. As stated in previously approved agreements, funding for this project will come from the Minnesota Air National Guard and the Minnesota department of transportation. The city of Duluth has no financial interest in and will bear no cost for this project. The Airport Perimeter Road runs around the west end of Runway 09 at the Duluth International Airport, approximately from the Cirrus building to Lavaque Road north of the airport. The aggregate base of the road was built in Phase 1 of the Airport Perimeter Road project, and will be paved under this agreement. Of the two firms that responded, Northland Constructors of Duluth, LLC, was the lowest bidder. The engineer's estimate was \$910,631; payable out of Permanent Improvement Fund 0411, Department/Agency 035, Object 5530, City Project No. 0677TR, Requisition No. 08-05573.
