RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH ST. LOUIS COUNTY FOR THE FURNISHING OF HOME-DELIVERED MEALS FOR THE PERIOD FROM JANUARY 1, 2008, TO DECEMBER 31, 2008, AT THE REIMBURSEMENT RATE SET FORTH THEREIN.

CITY PROPOSAL:

RESOLVED, that the proper city officers are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with St. Louis County, a copy of which is on file in the office of the city clerk as Public Document No. _____, for the furnishing of home-delivered meals for senior citizens for the period of January 1, 2008, through December 31, 2008, at the reimbursement rate of \$2.00 per eligible non-waiver meal and \$6.20 per eligible waiver meal until September 30, 2008, and at the rate of \$2.00 per eligible non-waiver meal and \$6.32 per eligible waiver meal thereafter, said sums to be paid into Federal Program Fund 272, Department 031, Revenue Source 4654-02.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution authorizes a continuation of the contract with the St. Louis County board for their Title III-C (2) home-delivered meals program. The county has a contract for the home-delivered meals program with the Arrowhead Area Agency on Aging and sub-contracts with the city to provide home-delivered meals in the Morgan Park and Gary-New Duluth neighborhoods, at the Woodland Gardens Apartments, the Faith Haven Apartments and at Ramsey Manor.

The home-delivered meals are prepared and packaged at the city's Morgan Park, Evergreen and Woodland Congregate meal sites. During the first nine months of the contract, the county will reimburse the city monthly for each meal served: at the rate of \$2.00 for clients that make a personal donation for their meal and at the rate of \$6.20 for clients on the elderly waiver program. After September 30th, the rate for clients on the elderly waiver program will go to \$6.32.
