STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: Due to financial difficulties, the City decided to close city operations four days this year (November 10 and 17, December 26 and 31). A provision in the collective bargaining agreement with AFSCME permits the city to generally reduce their workweek by four days. This supplemental agreement provides that members of the association will use four days of vacation by the end of the year to cover those days. The remaining bargaining units have committed verbally to a similar arrangement.
