Alcohol, gambling and tobacco commission discussion of 11/5/2008: Timothy Timbers was present on behalf of the application. Mr. Timbers explained that he is opening a new establishment on the first floor of the building which will have a sports bar theme offering various appetizers and sandwiches. To questioning from the commission, he replied that he and his partner have 30 years experience in the restaurant industry and will sending all the managers and staff to alcohol training classes. He continued saying that they will be having DJ's on the weekends and will be hiring bouncers and off duty police officers to check ID's. To further questioning, Mr. Timbers stated that they hope to be open by December 19. Officer Vang stated he has approved this application. There being no further discussion, Mr. Wright moved THAT THE APPLICATION OF CLUB FRICTION, LLC (SCORE SPORTS BAR & GRILL), 21 NORTH FOURTH AVENUE WEST FOR AN ON SALE INTOXICATING LIQUOR LICENSE, ON SALE SUNDAY LICENSE, DANCING LICENSE AND 2:00 A.M. BEVERAGE LICENSE FOR THE PERIOD ENDING AUGUST 31, 2009, WITH TIMOTHY TIMBERS, 51 PERCENT OWNER, AND DAVID KOELLER, 49 PERCENT OWNER, BE APPROVED AND THE SAME BE RECOMMENDED TO THE CITY COUNCIL FOR APPROVAL.
