Alcohol, gambling and tobacco commission discussion of 11/5/2008: Luke Moravec was present on behalf of the application. Mr. Moravec explained that they are having an AIDS benefit dance at St. Scholastica on December 6, and they would like to serve 3.2 beer at the event. He continued saying that they will be having a beer garden in a separate room from the dance and no one will be allowed to leave the beer garden with their drink. To the commission's questioning, Mr. Moravec replied that they will be hiring off duty police officers along with campus security to check ID's and students will be wearing wristbands identifying them if they are able to drink beer. Officer Vang stated he has approved this application. There being no further discussion, Mr. Hanson moved THAT THE APPLICATION OF COLLEGE OF ST. SCHOLASTICA, 1200 KENWOOD AVENUE, FOR A TEMPORARY ON SALE 3.2 PERCENT MALT LIQUOR LICENSE FOR DECEMBER 6, 2008, WITH LUKE MORAVEC, MANAGER, BE APPROVED AND THE SAME BE RECOMMENDED TO THE CITY COUNCIL FOR APPROVAL.
