RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CITY OFFICIALS TO CONTRACT WITH MONARCH PAVING COMPANY, DIVISION OF MATHY CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, FOR THE PURCHASE OF COLD MIX ASPHALT TO BE PICKED UP BY DECEMBER 31, 2008, FOR AN ESTIMATED TOTAL OF \$95,258.93.

CITY PROPOSAL:

RESOLVED, that city officials are hereby authorized to contract with Monarch Paving Company, a Division of Mathy Construction Company, for the purchase of 1,500 tons of cold mix asphalt to be picked up by December 31, 2008, for the department of public works and utilities in accordance with city specifications and the vendor's quote of \$59.63 per ton, for a total of \$89,445 plus \$5,813.93 sales tax, for a combined total of \$95,258.93, terms net 30, FOB picked up and payable from the following funds:

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution authorizes the purchase of 1,500 tons of cold mix asphalt from Monarch Paving Company, a Division of Mathy Construction Company, in Superior Wisconsin. The quote is \$59.63 per ton for a total amount of \$95,258.93 (including sales tax) and payable from the general, water, gas, sewer, and stormwater funds. This includes 700 tons for street maintenance and 800 tons for utilities.

This will be picked up by city of Duluth personnel by December 31, 2008, and used this winter for various public works and utilities projects.

The previous contract awarded to Northland Constructors of Duluth, LLC, Resolution 08-0301 on May 12, 2008, must be cancelled as they are unable to supply the city's needs. The purchasing division will open a new bid process in 2009.
