RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING WATER RATES EFFECTIVE WITH METER READINGS AFTER FEBRUARY 1, 2009; RESCINDING ALL PRIOR INCONSISTENT OR CONFLICTING RESOLUTIONS WITH RESPECT TO SUCH RATES.

CITY PROPOSAL:

RESOLVED, effective with the water meter readings after February 1, 2009, all customers of the water utility of the city of Duluth, whose water supply is measured by meter, shall be charged for such water in accordance with the schedule of rates established by this resolution as follows:

first 4,000 cubic feet, per 100 cubic feet	\$2.56	<del>\$2.41</del>

over 1,000,000 cubic feet, per 100 cubic feet	\$1.15	<del>\$1.08</del>

For consumers requiring water at an elevation in excess of 290 feet above Lake Superior, the rate for all water in excess of 100,000 cubic feet per month shall be effective February 1, 2009, \$1.67 per 100 cubic feet.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution sets water rates effective with meter readings after February 1, 2009. The 6.1% rate increase to be authorized by this resolution will realize an estimate of \$581,000 in new revenue to meet rising costs of approximately \$268,000 for water treatment chemicals, \$269,000 for utilities and \$44,000 for other operating expenses.
