Alcohol, gambling and tobacco commission discussion of 12/3/2008: John Omundson and Pamela Houle were present on behalf of the application. Mr. Omundson explained that they are in the process of buying the Kom On Inn establishment and hope to have the deal closed by the end of the month. To questioning from the commission, Ms. Houle replied that she has been a bartender and manager of another liquor establishment for three years and is becoming familiar with the rules and regulations of the City Code. To further questioning, Mr. Omundson stated they plan on putting in a kitchen to be able to serve food on a daily basis which would comply with the Sunday liquor code requirement. Officer Vang stated he has approved this application.
