RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ACCEPTING A GRANT OF \$5,000 AND AN AGENCY AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND MN/DOT FOR FEDERAL PARTICIPATION IN PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING FOR LINCOLN PARK SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL EDUCATION, ENCOURAGEMENT AND ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM.

CITY PROPOSAL:

RESOLVED, that pursuant to Minnesota Statute Sec. 161.36, the commissioner of transportation be appointed as agent to the city of Duluth to accept, as its agent, federal aid funds which may be made available for eligible transportation-related projects.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the proper city officials are hereby authorized to execute an agreement with the commissioner of transportation, on file in the office of the city clerk as Public Document No. _____, prescribing the terms and conditions of said federal aid participation as set forth and contained in Minnesota department of transportation agency Agreement No. 93808.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution authorizes the proper city officials to enter into an agreement with the state of Minnesota department of transportation to receive federal funds for the development of a safe routes to school education, encouragement and enforcement program for the Duluth public school district ISD 709, identified as State Project No. 118-591-002, Minnesota Project No. SRTS 6908(203), and City Project No. 0655TR. This project will develop a safety program for students at Lincoln Park School, which will be used at other ISD 709 schools when Lincoln Park School is no longer in use. It is anticipated that 100 percent (\$5,000) of the cost of this project will be paid from federal funds made available by the federal highway administration. Costs will be paid from the Permanent Improvement Fund 0411 until reimbursed by Mn/DOT.
