Alcohol, gambling and tobacco commission discussion of 12/3/2008: Luke Moravec was present on behalf of the application. He continued saying that they will be having a separate beer garden in the Reif Center along with the band. To the commission's questioning, Mr. Moravec replied that they will be hiring three off duty police officers along with campus security to check ID's, and students will be wearing wristbands identifying them if they are able to drink beer. Officer Vang stated he has approved this application. There being no further discussion, Mr. Hanson moved THAT THE APPLICATION OF COLLEGE OF ST.
