RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CITY OFFICIALS TO REIMBURSE ST. LOUIS COUNTY PROPERTY MANAGEMENT 50 PERCENT OF THE 2008 COSTS IN UPGRADING THE SHARED PUBLIC IMPOUND LOT ON NORTH ARLINGTON AVENUE IN DULUTH FOR THE AMOUNT OF \$30,480.43.

CITY PROPOSAL:

RESOLVED, that city officials are hereby authorized to reimburse St. Louis County property management 50 percent of the 2008 costs in upgrading the shared public impound lot at the St. Louis County public safety building on 2030 Arlington Avenue North in Duluth for an amount of \$30,480.43, payable from the following accounts:

(a) \$3,163.05 from General Fund 100, Agency 200, Organization 1640-2232, Object 5241;

(b) \$6,951.88 from General Fund 100, Agency 200, Organization 1640-2233, Object 5441; and

(c) \$20,365.50 from Duluth Police Grant Programs Fund 215, Agency 200, Organization 2261, Object 5580.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution authorizes the reimbursement of \$30,480.43 to St. Louis County property management for 50 percent of its 2008 expenses in improving the shared public impound lot at the St. Louis County Public Safety Building on 2030 Arlington Avenue North. The city's portion is payable from the General Fund and Duluth police grant programs fund.

The expenses cover fencing, gravel, storage containers and other items related to improvements. Fencing was the biggest expense. The electrical wiring for the impound lot gate has yet to be completed.
