Northland Vietnam Veterans Association, Bayfront Park, for August 7, 8 and 9, 2009, the serving ceasing at 9:30 p.m. with Kathy Camps, manager.

Alcohol, gambling and tobacco commission discussion:

MARSHALL SCHOOL (MARSHALL AUCTION), 1215 RICE LAKE ROAD - APPLICATION FOR A TEMPORARY ON SALE INTOXICATING LIQUOR LICENSE FOR MAY 1, 2009, WITH BARBARA BRUEGGEMANN, MANAGER.

Shannon Hoffman was present on behalf of the application. She noted that this is their 22nd annual auction that is by invitation only to individuals over 21 years of age. To further questioning, she stated that there will be student workers with adult supervision serving food, but the drinks will only be served from a service bar to the guests. Ms. Hoffman also stated that they will be hiring an off duty officer. Officer Vang stated that the police department recommends approval. There being no further discussion, Mr. Hanson moved that THE APPLICATION OF MARSHALL SCHOOL, 1215 RICE LAKE ROAD, FOR A TEMPORARY ON SALE INTOXICATING LIQUOR LICENSE FOR MAY 1, 2009, WITH BARBARA BRUEGGEMANN, MANAGER, BE APPROVED AND THE SAME BE RECOMMENDED TO THE CITY COUNCIL FOR APPROVAL. Kathy Camps was present on behalf of the application. Ms. Camps explained that they are applying for a temporary liquor license to serve beer and wine at the Blues Fest at Bayfront Park. To questioning from the commission, Ms. Camps replied that they will have off duty police officers working the event, and the operation will run the same as they have done in the past with a police officer checking ID's and using wrist bands to identify those over 21. To questioning from the commission, Ms. Camps replied that they serve alcohol until 9:30 p.m. and the music stops at 9:45 .m.
