STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: On February 9, 2009, a city watermain ruptured causing water to penetrate and damage the basement of property located at 620 Woodland Avenue and owned by Mohammed El Damir.

The city's liability is based upon the legal principle that it is under a duty to maintain its watermains in a reasonably safe condition. The city of Duluth has investigated this claim and verified the damages and expenses. The civil division of the city attorney's office analyzed the city's loss exposure. Settlement negotiations were conducted and an agreement has been reached in the amount of \$13,560.73. The city attorney's office recommends this settlement.
