RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CITY OFFICIALS TO CONTRACT WITH NELSON AUTO CENTER FOR THE PURCHASE AND DELIVERY OF A 2009 GMC SIERRA 3500 ONE-TON 4WD REGULAR CAB AND CHASSIS FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$30,650.17.

CITY PROPOSAL:

WHEREAS, the city purchasing division received a request for the purchase of a 2009 one-ton, 4x4 regular cab and chassis; and

WHEREAS, a request for bids was solicited and the state of Minnesota contract for such a purchase was reviewed; and

WHEREAS, the city purchasing division compared the lowest solicited bid with the state of Minnesota contract bid and found the state bid to be lower; and

WHEREAS, a requisition for Nelson Auto Center was then received.

RESOLVED, that city officials are hereby authorized to contract with Nelson Auto Center for the purchase and delivery of a 2009 GMC Sierra 3500 4WD regular cab and chassis with options and accessories in accordance with state of Minnesota Contract #440160, Release T-636(5), specifications and pricing in the amount of \$28,662.13 plus \$1,863.04 sales tax plus \$125 tax exempt plates, title, and registration, for a combined total amount of \$30,650.17, terms net 30, FOB

destination, payable from the Capital Equipment Fund 250, Agency 015, Organization 2009, Object 5580, Project CE250-V905.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution authorizes the purchase and delivery of a 2009 GMC Sierra 3500 4WD regular cab and chassis from Nelson Auto Center for \$28,662.13 plus \$1,863.04 sales tax plus \$125 plates, title and registration for a total of \$30,650.17, payable from the capital equipment fund.

This purchase is based on state of Minnesota Contract #440160, T-636(5). This new vehicle will replace Park Maintenance Unit #3851 or 3322, and be outfitted with hydraulics, dumpbody and Vplow.

The purchasing division posted a request for bids on the website March 24, 2009. Boyer Ford Trucks submitted the lowest of three complete bids received by the closing date. However, the purchasing division found that the state contract with Nelson Auto Center was the lowest bid.
