RESOLUTION AMENDING CONTRACT C-19868 FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES WITH CAMP, DRESSER AND McKEE, INC., FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A LONG TERM PLAN FOR EVALUATION AND ELIMINATION OF OVERFLOWS IN THE CITY'S SANITARY SEWER COLLECTION SYSTEM IN THE ESTIMATED AMOUNT OF \$423,756 FOR A NEW TOTAL OF \$1,009,769.

CITY PROPOSAL:

RESOLVED, that Resolution 05-0046 awarding a contract to Camp, Dresser and McKee, Inc., for engineering services for the development of a long term plan for the evaluation and elimination of sanitary sewer overflows in the city's sanitary sewer collection system be hereby amended to increase the contract amount for Phase IV flow monitoring, modeling and analysis work for basins 23 through 30, preparation of I&I removal plan and preparation of remedial measures plan, all required by the consent decree, in the amount of \$423,756 for a new total of \$1,009,769. The increase of \$423,756 will be payable from the Clean Water Fund 0532, Agency 500, Object 5532, City Project No. 0511SN.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: Resolution 05-0046, passed on January 24, 2005, awarded a contract to Camp, Dresser and McKee, Inc., for the development of a long term plan for evaluation and elimination of the sanitary sewer overflows in the city's wastewater collection system. This resolution will amend CDM's contract (C-19858) to include Phase IV monitoring, modeling and analysis work in basins 23 through 30, the preparation of an I&I removal plan, and the preparation of a remedial measures plan. This work is a result of the requirements of the city's consent decree with the EPA. The additional cost in the amount of \$423,756 will be payable from Clean Water Fund 0532, Agency 500, Object 5532, City Project No. 0511SN.
