Alcohol, gambling, and tobacco commission discussion of 5/6/2009: John Vaydich was present on behalf of the application. Mr. Vaydich explained that there will be a celebrity softball game held at the Wheeler complex on June 12 which will include past players of the Minnesota Vikings and Minnesota Twins. He continued saying that there will be only one game played starting at 5:00 p.m. with everything shut down by 10:00 p.m. as the event will move to Mr. D's Bar. To questioning from the commission, Mr. Vaydich replied they have secured liquor liability insurance and have hired a private security firm for the event. Officer Vang stated he has approved this application. There being no further discussion, Mr. Wright moved that THE APPLICATION OF DULUTH SOFTBALL PLAYERS ASSOCIATION, (DSPA), WHEELER FIELD , FOR A TEMPORARY ON SALE 3.2 PERCENT MALT LIQUOR LICENSE FOR JUNE 12, 2009, WITH JOHN VAYDICH MANAGER, BE APPROVED, AND THE SAME BE RECOMMENDED TO THE CITY COUNCIL FOR APPROVAL.
