STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: Because of changes in the way metered gas amounts are reported, the need for personnel to read meters has decreased. The changes reflect the changing duties for personnel in that title to allow them to test and repair gas and water meters, regulators and relief valves. There was also some revision of outdated language. There is no change in the rate of pay, which is Range 22, \$2,706 to \$3,166 per month.
