RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT TO RICE LAKE CONSTRUCTION GROUP FOR THE LAKESIDE INTERCEPTOR SANITARY SEWER OVERFLOW STORAGE FACILITY IN BASIN NO. 2 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5,884,400.

RESOLVED, that the proper city officials are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Rice Lake Construction Group for the construction of the Lakeside interceptor sanitary sewer overflow storage facility in Basin No. 2 in the amount of \$5,884,400, which is being funded by a \$1,526,267 grant from the 2005 Bonding Bill, by a \$3,660,833 grant from ARRA, and with the remaining \$697,300 payable out of the Clean Water Fund 0532, Department/Agency 500, Object 5532, City Project No. 0696SN, Requisition No. 09-0289.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution will authorize the construction of the Lakeside interceptor sanitary sewer overflow storage facility in Basin No. 2 by Rice Lake Construction Group in the amount of \$5,884,400. The costs will be funded by a \$1,526,267 grant from the 2005 bonding bill, by a \$3,660,833 grant from ARRA, and the remaining \$697,300 will be funded from the Clean Water Fund 0532, Department/Agency 500, Object 5532, City Project No. 0696SN, Requisition No. 09-0289. Rice Lake Construction Group was the lowest bidder of the seven companies that responded, and their bid was ten per cent below the engineer's estimate of \$6,500,000.
