RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT TO INSTRUMENT CONTROL SYSTEMS FOR THE COMPREHENSIVE SUPERVISORY CONTROL AND DATA ACQUISITION SYSTEM (SCADA) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,797,789.

RESOLVED, that the proper city officials are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Instrument Control Systems for a supervisory control and data acquisition system for the city of Duluth's natural gas, water and wastewater utilities, for the apparent low bid of \$2,797,789, with \$1,440,228 payable out of the Gas Utility Fund 0520, \$977,519 payable out of the Sanitary Sewer Utility Fund 0530, and \$380,042 payable out of the Water Utility Fund 0510, Department/Agency 500, Object 5533, City Project No. 0047GS.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution will authorize the construction of a supervisory control and data acquisition system by Instrument Control Systems, with \$1,440,228 payable from the Gas Utility Fund 0510, \$977,519 payable from the Sanitary Sewer Utility Fund 0530, and \$380,042 payable from the Water Utility Fund 0510. Instrument Control Systems was the lowest bidder of the three companies that responded. Their bid was seven per cent below the engineer's estimate of \$3,000,000. Requisition No. 09-10DS, City Project No. 0047GS, Department/Agency 500, Object 5533.
