RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A PUBLIC HOUSING COMMUNITY BASED POLICE OFFICER AGREEMENT WITH THE HOUSING AND REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY OF DULUTH, MINNESOTA (HRA), PAYMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$50,000 TO BE MADE BY THE HRA TO THE CITY.

RESOLVED, that the proper city officials are authorized to enter into a public housing community based police officer agreement, substantially in the form of that on file in the office of the city clerk as Public Document No. _____, with the Housing and Redevelopment Authority of Duluth, Minnesota (HRA), pursuant to which the HRA will pay the city \$50,000 for the services of a Duluth police officer who will work pro-actively to provide security services and improve the social conditions at the HRA's public housing sites, payable into Fund 110-160-1610-4261.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution authorizes an agreement with the HRA pursuant to which a Duluth police officer will work proactively to provide security services and improve the social conditions at the HRA's public housing sites. This position will aid crime prevention at these sites and free up additional police resources in the community. The HRA sites to be served by the officer are King Manor, Grandview Manor, Tri-Towers, Midtowne Manors I and II, Ramsey Manor and 294 public housing scattered site homes throughout Duluth. The city will be paid \$50,000 for these services.
