STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution will authorize the award of a contract for the reconditioning of Second Street from Mesaba Avenue to 24th Avenue East and conversion and widening of Sixth Avenue East to allow two-way traffic from Second Street to Third Street to Ulland Brothers, Inc., in the amount of \$3,521,440.14. This will be paid from the Permanent Improvement Fund 0411, Agency 035, Object 5530, with the majority to be reimbursed by Mn/DOT with turnback funds. The city is responsible for the additional work not covered by the turnback project, including utility improvements, Sixth Avenue East, and the portion of Second Street from 21st Avenue East to 24th Avenue East. Ulland Brothers, Inc., was the low bidder of the two companies who submitted bids. The engineer's estimate for this project was \$3,616,800.
