STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution authorizes an agreement with St. Louis County (sheriff) for four quarters of shield maintenance software associated with NEMESIS (Northeastern Minnesota enforcement and safety information system) in the amount of \$52,582, payable from the general fund.

User fees were subsidized by a grant during the initial years of the program.

NEMESIS is designed to provide shared integrated resources for public safety agencies to track information regarding people, incidents, and cases throughout the criminal justice system. It connects local and statewide criminal and court systems to strengthen public safety in Minnesota.
