STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution is to authorize city officials to accept a grant of \$344,008 from the Senior Service America, Inc., (SSAI) to provide funds to service Duluth residents age 55 and over with work experience training and services.

The grant requires a local contribution of \$45,093. This entire amount will be provided through in-kind contributions of local agencies and city supervisor and/or indirect costs. Program funds will be accepted upon receipt of notices of funds available. Monies received shall be deposited in Fund 270, Agency 031, Organization 6330.

These funds are allocated under Title V of the Older American Act. The fund will provide part-time work experience and training for a minimum of 63 senior citizens. The grant period is July 1, 2009, to June 30, 2010.
