STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution will authorize the reconstruction of the Arlington pump station by Gridor Construction, Inc., in the amount of \$1,389,000, with costs to be paid from the Water Bond Fund 511 and reimbursed through a PFA loan. Gridor Construction, Inc., was the lowest bidder of the four companies that submitted bids. Their bid was 41 percent below the engineer's estimate of \$2,366,848; payable out of Department/Agency 500, Object 5532, City Project No. 0695WA, Requisition No. 09-0458.
