RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PROPER CITY OFFICIALS TO CONTRACT WITH WASTE MANAGEMENT OF MINNESOTA, INC., (CANYON) FOR THE PURPOSE OF LANDFILL TIPPING FEES IN THE DISPOSAL OF AN ESTIMATED 2,500 TONS OF BOILER ASH FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$55,125.

RESOLVED, that city officials are hereby authorized to contract with Waste Management of Minnesota, Inc., (Canyon) for the purpose of landfill tipping fees in the disposal of an estimated 2,500 tons of boiler ash in accordance with city specifications and the vendor's bid of \$55,125, terms net 30, payable from Steam Fund 540, Department/Agency 920, Organization 1490, Object 5388.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: The resolution authorizes \$55,125 for landfill tipping fees to Waste Management of Minnesota, Inc., (Canyon) payable from the steam fund. This involves the disposal of an estimated 2,500 tons of boiler ash.

The purchasing division posted a request for bids July 29, 2009, on the city's website. Three complete bids were received by the closing date. Veolia Environmental Services, the lowest bid, was not selected because when combined with the hauling fee, it was not the most reasonable. The Canyon site is.

The contract period runs from October 1, 2009, through September 30, 2010, with two additional one-year renewal options.
