RESOLUTION AMENDING CONTRACT NO. C20859 WITH MSA PROFESSIONAL SERVICES, INC., FOR DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE EAST INTERCEPTOR SANITARY SEWER OVERFLOW STORAGE FACILITY IN THE ESTIMATED AMOUNT OF \$384,323.23 FOR A NEW TOTAL OF \$2,191,782.23.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: Resolution 09-0240, passed on April 13, 2009, awarded a contract to MSA Professional Services, Inc., for engineering services related to the design and construction of a sanitary sewer overflow (SSO) storage facility to contain flow from the east interceptor. This resolution will amend the contract to include design and construction engineering services for a control structure and diversion sewer from Third Avenue East and Superior Street to the new SSO tank, additional engineering services related to splitting the original project into two construction phases, additional flow monitoring and flow modeling work, additional environmental remediation work and additional landscape renderings and conceptual drawings. The additional cost of \$384,323.23 will be payable from Clean Water Fund 532, Agency 500, Object 5532, City Project No. 0519SN.
