STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution is a request to the state to allow the city to revoke the municipal state aid (MSA) route designation for Anoka Street between Maxwell Avenue and Howard Gnesen Road. Portions of this route were designated as MSA routes in both 1964 and 1969. This request is to help "clean up" the city's MSA system to more accurately show routes that will be constructed. Because this has been on the improvement list for so long without any progress, we propose to take the designation off this segment. In the future, if mileage is available, the city can request that the route be redesignated prior to construction.
