STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution is a request to the state to allow the city to revoke the Municipal State Aid (MSA) route designation for 10th Avenue East between Kenwood Avenue and Ninth Street. This segment is not in the area proposed for reconstruction during the 2013 construction season. This route was the future "Kenwood Connector" that has been studied over the years since its designation as an MSA route in 1972. This request is to help "clean up" the city's MSA system to more accurately show routes that will be constructed. Because this has been on the improvement list for so long without any progress, we propose to take the designation off this segment. In the future, if mileage is available, the city can request that the route be redesignated prior to construction.
