STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This classification has been created to maintain control of evidence and recovered property, including inventorying and safekeeping of property and maintaining records and reports. This classification is grant funded, and will aid the police department in addressing critical issues they are facing involving the storage and disposal of evidence and recovered property. The pay range negotiated for the classification is Range 22, \$2,706 to \$3,166 per month.
