STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution authorizes city application for a \$91,500 grant from the environmental protection agency and, if selected, implementation of the grant to fund the Miller and Coffee Creek sediment management project. The project entails construction of a hard surfaced structure meant to delineate sediment removal boundaries, improve sediment extractions, and reestablish a normal flow channel; in addition to the installation of erosion prevention measures along the streambanks of Miller and Coffee Creek.
