RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR AND, IF SELECTED, ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT FROM THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY THROUGH THE GREAT LAKES RESTORATION INITIATIVE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$239,705 FOR A PROJECT ENTITLED AMITY BANK AND UPPER GRAVES ROAD TRIBUTARY RESTORATION.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution authorizes city application for a \$239,705 grant from the environmental protection agency and, if selected, implementation of the grant to fund the Amity Bank and Upper Graves Road tributary restoration project. The project first entails rehabilitation of a section of tributary along Graves Road near Amity Creek, which as been damaged by increased storm sewer discharge due to increased upstream development. The second portion of the project is the rehabilitation of a severely eroded red clay stream bank in an upper section of Amity Creek. Restoration techniques would include sloping, stabilization and re-vegetation as necessary to prevent further erosion and eliminate the resulting sedimentation and turbidity issues.
