Alcohol, gambling and tobacco commission discussion of 1/6/2010: Luke Moravec was present on behalf of the application. Mr. Moravec explained that this is their annual Snowball Dance being held at the Reif Center at St. Scholastica on February 6th. He continued that they will be using a wrist band system they have used in the past to identify students 21 and over, and they have contacted the Duluth police department and will be hiring four off duty police officers for the dance. Officer Vang stated he has talked with Mr. Moravec and have agreed upon security for the dance. To questioning from the commission, Mr. Moravec replied they were late in sending in the application as the application was waiting for a signature from the college's financial officer and sitting on his desk over Christmas vacation.
