RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF OVERTIME REIMBURSEMENT FUNDS FROM THE NORTHEAST LAW ENFORCEMENT ADMINISTRATORS COUNCIL IN AN AMOUNT ESTIMATED NOT TO EXCEED \$22,000 FOR DULUTH POLICE DEPARTMENT PARTICIPATION IN A METHAMPHETAMINE INITIATIVE.

RESOLVED, that the proper city officials are hereby authorized to accept overtime reimbursement funds for Duluth police department participation in a methamphetamine reduction initiative from the Northeast Law Enforcement Administrators Council through its fiscal agent the city of Chisholm, in an amount estimated not to exceed \$22,000 and to be applied for on an as needed basis through December 31, 2011, funds to be deposited in Fund 215-200-2287-4209-02.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution authorizes the proper city officials to accept overtime reimbursement funds from the city of Chisholm as fiscal agent for the Northeast Law Enforcement Administrators Council("NLEAC"). NLEAC is the recipient of a grant through the U.S. Department of Justice for a methamphetamine initiative entitled the "COPS Methamphetamine Initiative" which will combat methamphetamine production, distribution, and use in northeast Minnesota. As a partner in the initiative the Duluth police department is eligible for overtime reimbursement available through the grant.

The term of the grant runs through December 31, 2011. The police department expects to apply for funds on an as needed basis for a total amount not to exceed \$22,000. NLEAC has already approved \$5,000 for Duluth police department overtime reimbursement.
