RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AGREEMENT WITH INFOR GLOBAL SOLUTIONS (MICHIGAN), INC., FOR INSTALLATION AND SERVICE OF A COMPUTERIZED ASSET MAINTENANCE AND MANAGEMENT SYSTEM FOR ITS WASTEWATER COLLECTION AND TREATMENT SYSTEM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$278,625.96.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: The purpose of this resolution is to authorize an agreement with Infor Global Solutions (Michigan), Inc. ,to acquire and use their computerized maintenance and management system in connection with the city's wastewater collection and transmission system.

Pursuant to the consent decree in the lawsuit brought by the USEPA and the MPCA to address sanitary sewer overflows into Lake Superior, the city is required to put in place a system to manage maintenance of its sanitary sewer equipment and facilities with a goal of reducing or eliminating such overflows due to system failures.

In the Fall of 2009, the city sent out a request for proposals for a computerized maintenance and management system which could be installed on the city's systems and which could meet this goal. Eight responses were received and after extensive deliberation, a technical review panel unanimously selected Infor Global's proposal as the best and most responsive received.

Pursuant to their proposal, Infor Global will license the city to use its software and install applications on City equipment which will allow the city to use that software. They will initially test the installations to insure their proper function and, during the remainder of the one year term of the agreement, thereafter provide the city with updates and assist the city in using the program. The city will have the option of extending the servicing portion of the agreement on an annual basis.
