STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: The parking meter monitor job description is being revised to reflect the changed requirements for the classification, including the use of computers versus the older terminals. Also, as the classification requires skills dealing with parking enforcement, a one year enforcement educational requirement was added. There is no change in the rate of pay, which is Range 18, \$2,330 to \$2,706 per month.
