STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution authorizes an agreement with the Northeast Law Enforcement Administrators Council (NLEAC). NLEAC applied for and received \$1,175,000 in federal grant assistance funds under the targeted-methamphetamine initiative COPS program. The grant funds were used in part to purchase equipment to assist NLEAC personnel who work on methamphetamine cases. As a member of NLEAC, the Duluth police department will use this equipment with the consent of NLEAC to investigate the manufacture, sale, and use of methamphetamine and other related drugs.
