STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: This resolution will authorize the construction of one, two, three, six and eight inch high pressure plastic gas mains, 1/2 and one inch plastic gas services, and related work in various locations throughout the city of Duluth by NPL Construction Company in the amount of \$407,446. This award is the annual project for extending gas mains and gas services to new customers and may include some replacement gas services. NPL Construction Company was the lowest responsible bidder of the four companies that responded. The bid is four percent above the engineer's estimate of \$392,725. Payable out of Gas Fund 520, Department/Agency 500, Organization 1905, Object 5533, City Project No. 0884GS, Requisition No. 10-0202.
