Alcohol, gambling and tobacco commission discussion of 1/6/2010: Luke Moravec was present on behalf of the application. Mr. Moravec explained that the college is having a Mayfest celebration that includes a Johnny Holm dance, and they would like to serve 3.2 beer at the event. He continued saying that they will be having a beer garden in a separate room from the dance, and no one will be allowed to leave the beer garden with their drink. To the commission's questioning, Mr. Moravec replied that they will be hiring four off duty police officers along with campus security to check ID's, and students will be wearing wristbands identifying them if they are able to drink beer. The clerk stated that Officer Vang has approved this application. There being no further discussion, Mr. Hammack moved THAT THE APPLICATION OF COLLEGE OF ST. SCHOLASTICA, 1200 KENWOOD AVENUE, FOR A TEMPORARY ON SALE 3.2 PERCENT MALT LIQUOR LICENSE FOR APRIL 30, 2010, WITH LUKE MORAVEC, MANAGER, BE APPROVED AND THE SAME BE RECOMMENDED TO THE CITY COUNCIL FOR APPROVAL.
