Grandma's, Inc. (Grandma's Saloon & Grill), 522 Lake Avenue South,
for June 19, 2010, with the serving and music ceasing at 1:00 a.m.

Alcohol, gambling and tobacco commission discussion: Eric Robinson was present on behalf of the application. Mr. Robinson reviewed that they will be erecting an enclosed tent up in their parking lot where food, beverages, and music will be served in the tent until 1:00 a.m. He explained that extending the hours in the tent until 1:00 a.m. instead of midnight helps prevent the mad rush of people from the tent when it closes into the neighboring bars for the last hour of serving alcohol. He continued to say that there will be off duty police officers working in the tent along with their own security, and that during the evening hours no one under 21 is allowed in the tent. The clerk stated that Officer Vang has approved this application. There being no further discussion, Mr. Peterson moved that THE APPLICATION OF GRANDMA'S, INC. (GRANDMA'S SALOON & GRILL), 522 LAKE AVENUE SOUTH, FOR TEMPORARY EXPANSION OF THE LICENSED PREMISES OF THEIR ON SALE INTOXICATING LIQUOR LICENSE FOR JUNE 19, 2010, BE APPROVED AND THE SAME BE RECOMMENDED TO THE CITY COUNCIL FOR APPROVAL. Mr. Donahue seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.
