STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: The purpose of this resolution is to authorize the continuance of the contractual relationship between the state fire marshal and the city's fire department which allows the city to conduct required code inspections of local hotel facilities and allows the city to retain the inspection fees to cover its costs.

Under the State Fire Code, the state fire marshal is required to conduct code compliance inspections at least once every three years. For the past several years, the state fire marshal has contracted this out to the city for hotels within its jurisdiction. This resolution authorizes a three extension of this practice. The inspection fees cover the city's costs of performing the work.
