Alcohol, gambling and tobacco commission discussion of 5/5/2010: Ryan Kern was present on behalf of the application. Mr. Kern reviewed that the airshow will be held in July and they would like to be able to sell alcohol to the spectators. To questioning from the commission, Mr. Kern replied that the same procedures will be used for the airshow as was done two years ago with the gates opening 9:00 a.m. and closing at 6:00 p.m. and he has been working with the Duluth police department for security. Mr. Kern explained that this year there will be an additional event on Saturday night and they will be using a hangar for an event that includes a band from 6:00 p.m. to midnight and will have additional security in place for that event. There being no further discussion, Mr. Peterson moved that THE APPLICATION OF BONG HERITAGE CENTER (DULUTH AIRSHOW), 4127 GRINDEN DRIVE, FOR A TEMPORARY ON SALE INTOXICATING LIQUOR LICENSE FOR JULY 17-18, 2010, WITH RYAN KERN, MANAGER, BE APPROVED AND THE SAME BE RECOMMENDED TO THE CITY COUNCIL FOR APPROVAL.
