Alcohol, gambling, and tobacco commission discussion of 5/5/2010: Tony Bronson was present on behalf of the application. Mr. Bronson explained that on Grandma's Marathon evening, the energy drink company Red Bull would like promote their drink by setting up an area in the back of their bar where their truck would be set up with a sound system and have an area where people can play various types of video games. He continued saying the event would be from 5:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. and they would like to be able to have alcohol beverages and food in that area during that timeframe. To further questioning, he explained that they would go out the back kitchen door into the back parking lot into a 66x70 fenced in area, but the area would not be accessible for the public through the bar, but only from the outside. Officer Vang stated that Mr. Bronson has been working with the police department for security for this event. There being no further discussion, Mr. Peterson moved that THE APPLICATION OF GRANDMA'S SPORTS BAR AND GRILL, INC. (GRANDMA'S SPORT GARDEN), 425 LAKE AVENUE SOUTH, FOR TEMPORARY EXPANSION OF THEIR ON SALE INTOXICATING LIQUOR LICENSE FOR JUNE 19, 2010, BE APPROVED AND THE SAME BE RECOMMENDED TO THE CITY COUNCIL FOR APPROVAL. Mr. Pekkala seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.
