RESOLUTION APPROVING THE TEMPORARY EXPANSION OF THE ON SALE INTOXICATING LIQUOR LICENSE OF GRANDMA'S ANGIE'S, INC. (LITTLE ANGIE'S CANTINA), 11 EAST BUCHANAN STREET.

Grandma's Angie's, Inc. (Little Angie's Cantina), 11 East Buchanan Street, for June 19, 2010, with the serving ceasing at 2:00 a.m.

Alcohol, gambling and tobacco commission discussion of 4/7/2010: Tony Bronson was present on behalf of the application. The clerk explained that there are two applications represented by the two maps that were included in their packet. The clerk reviewed that the June application is in conjunction with Grandma's Marathon. The clerk explained that the special events license for the marathon closes the streets until approximately 4:00 p.m., allowing people to be out on the streets and sidewalks with their drinks. Mr. Bronson stated that they would like to be able to set up a bar and table and chairs on the sidewalk in front of the deck during the marathon where they put up a fajita stand and serve beer. He went on to explain that they are further requesting to keep the table and chairs out on the sidewalk after the street opens up in order to keep serving food and alcohol on the bricks and will put up fencing to contain the area as was done last year. The clerk stated that there will be a second special events

license closing that area of the sidewalk that will allow the licensee to enclose that area of the sidewalk. Mr. Bronson explained that because they are required to allow people to walk through the deck area without having to eat and drink, by having the area on the sidewalk it helps keep the access onto the deck and into the restaurant much easier. To questioning by the commission, Mr. Bronson replied that they would like to serve in both areas until 2:00 a.m. To questioning from the commission, the clerk stated that Officer Vang will be talking to Little Angie's about security and time frame. There being no further discussion, Mr. Birchland moved that THE APPLICATION OF GRANDMA'S ANGIE'S, INC. (LITTLE ANGIE'S CANTINA), 11 EAST BUCHANAN STREET, FOR TEMPORARY EXPANSION OF THEIR ON SALE INTOXICATING LIQUOR LICENSE FOR JUNE 19, 2010, BE APPROVED AND THE SAME BE RECOMMENDED TO THE CITY COUNCIL FOR APPROVAL. Mr. Donahue seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.
